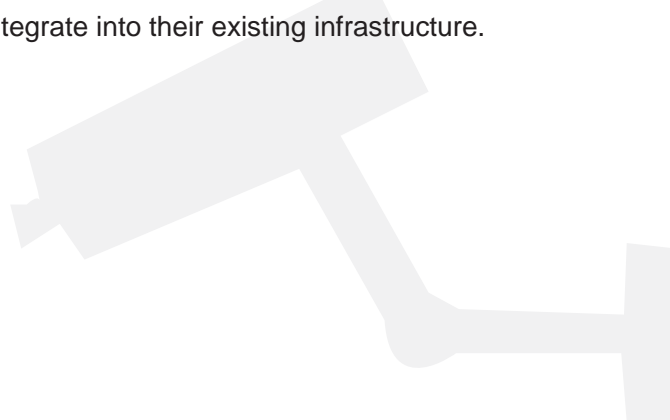
Project: Security Monitoring

Our client is the foremost producer of retail CD, DVD, Blu-Ray and Games and consequently is responsible for securely producing and storing titles in quantity ahead of their distribution and subsequent public launch.

Following security lapses at other such manufacturers, one such being the well-publicised theft by a member of staff of the new Harry Potter novel from its Suffolk printer ahead of its release in 2003 (the fork-lift driver allegedly tried to sell it to a newspaper for £25,000), distribution contracts are conditional on adequate supervision and asset protection.

Whilst the Client made the necessary changes to the site such as caged storage and access controlled entry systems, as we already had responsible for IT support at the site we were asked to investigate possible solutions.

The Client's requirement for event recording and replay, supervisory viewing from a number of locations around the site, plus the need for random remote checking, meant that an ip-CCTV was a natural choice which we could easily integrate into their existing infrastructure.
